To support its core oil sands operations, the company also owns or operates (in whole or in part) related midstream assets including the Stonefell Terminal in Alberta's Industrial Heartland (Operated by Access Pipeline Inc.)

Products

- Once operational, the HI-Q® Field Demonstration Pilot is planned to use low-intensity conversion processes to convert oil sands bitumen to a product similar to conventional heavy oil. This value-added product would be suitable for transportation by pipeline without needing to be blended with diluents.
