SCHOLARSHIP VALUE

Five (5) x \$1,000 scholarships. Scholarships will be awarded in August 2024.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Grade 12 students from each of the following high schools in Alberta's Industrial Heartland are invited to submit a short abstract and application form:

- 1. Fort Saskatchewan High School (Grades 10-12)
- 2. Sturgeon Composite High School (Grades 10-12)
- 3. Lamont High (Grades 7-12)
- 4. Redwater School (Grades 5-12)
- 5. Bev Facey Composite High School (Grades 10-12)
- 6. Salisbury Composite High School (Grades 10-12)
- 7. Archbishop Jordan Catholic High School (Grades 10-12)
- 8. Strathcona Christian Academy Secondary (Grades 7-12)
- 9. Ardrossan Junior Senior High School (Grades 7-12)
- 10. St. André Bessette Catholic School (Grades 9-12)

ELIGIBILITY

Students must:

- Be a Grade 12 student attending a high school in Alberta's Industrial Heartland (see list of schools above).
- Plan to attend post-secondary in September 2024 with aspirations to pursue a career in a STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) program, Environmental and Conversation Sciences program, or a trade.
- Be an Alberta resident.
- Demonstrate academics in good standing (B grade or above).
- Be involved in an extracurricular activity.

The student must also submit of a 300-500 word abstract on the following:

REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Submission of a 300-500 word abstract.
- 2. Application form must be filled out and signed by the student and Principal or Assistant Principal.
- 3. If selected for an award, students must provide proof of graduation.
- 4. Award recipients will be required to attend a photo opportunity in August 2024.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

June 30, 2024

SELECTION AND AWARD DISTRIBUTION

- Five students will be selected for a \$1,000 scholarship following a review by the selection committee of the application form and abstract. A total of five students will receive a \$1,000 scholarship each.
- Successful applicants will be notified by phone or email.
- Scholarship awards will be distributed in August 2024.
